TYLER WINIK OFFERS STATEMENT ON CONGRESSWOMAN SUZANNE KOSMAS
Winik Calls on Kosmas to Uphold Promised Vote for Healthcare Plan

TITUSVILLE, FLA – Tyler Winik issued a statement Saturday morning calling for Congresswoman Suzanne Kosmas (D-Florida) to uphold her promised yes vote on a healthcare bill before the U.S. House of Representatives:

“When Congresswoman Kosmas was campaigning across District 24, she not only called on a different type of politics to be employed in that the constituents of the district needed a Congressperson who would hear their issues and act boldly, but she made a promise to vote for and support common-sense, inclusive legislation for every citizen regardless income level—including healthcare legislation.

Congresswoman Kosmas’ announcement yesterday that she will be voting against the healthcare plan before Congress today—a plan that has been vetted in Committee process by Democrats and Republicans and a plan she previously endorsed—is not only ridiculous, but is a renegeing of her promise to residents of District 24.

After having spoken with the Congresswoman’s press secretary yesterday, I am confident that she will not change her vote. This is a mistake, and I believe a bad campaign move for her and her advisors.”
